

The Women in Auto Care Awards are administered by the Women in Auto Care Leadership Council, alongside volunteer industry volunteers. Winners are recognized at the Women in Auto Care awards ceremony and reception during AAPEX in Las Vegas, as well as via both Women in Auto Care and Auto Care Association media channels.

Educating and Connecting

- Women in Auto Care provides opportunities, education and career leadership to women in the auto care industry through conferences, networking, scholarships, education, data, awards and more.
- In 2023, we stood up our Connection Circles program. Connection Circles are an informal, virtual way to connect with other Women in Auto Care members. Each month we host Connection Circles, online events which connect participants in a casual setting for engaging professional development and networking with their peers.
- In 2022, we launched a monthly "Empower Half Hour" series. These podcast-style interviews are on the second Friday of each month, hear from women who are shaping the aftermarket industry and learn from the career journey.



Scholarships

Established in 2004, the Women in Auto Care scholarship program is proud to support high school and post-secondary female students seeking a career in auto care. Over the years we have increased our annual scholarships from \$2,000 in 2005 to more than to \$413,000 in 2023.

How Partnerships Help Us Grow

In 2020, a newly-forged partnership with Garage Gurus allowed us to create a secondary scholarship initiative which provides \$35,000 in tuition toward the spring semester to aspiring female technicians. In 2021, Genuine Parts NAPA stepped up as the primary toolkit sponsor. The Carlyle Tools by NAPA toolkit program awards more than \$100,000 in toolkits each year. In 2022, Acuity followed suit, donating \$20,000 to help grow the tool program even further. In 2023, we have added a \$10,000 partnership with Dorman for an additional scholarship.
